

City of Waterville
Open Burning
October 15 to December 15, 2015

THE FOLLOWING OPEN BURNING CONDITIONS APPLY:

Fire must be at least 25' from other buildings

No Burning Allowed on any road

Keep this fire under control and to assume responsibility for all that may result from burning done.

Attend this fire until completely extinguished.

Not to burn if there is a practical alternative method for disposal of materials.

A clean burning device is to be used to start the fire.

Not to conduct burning during an air quality alert.

Not to burn paper, cardboard, treated wood, construction lumber except as provided under MN Statutes 17.135.

Prevailing wind must be away from nearby occupied buildings.

Fires will not be allowed to smolder or create excess smoke without flame.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS ARE: Oils, rubber, plastics, tires and chemically treated materials such as railroad ties, treated lumber, shingles, tar insulation, composite board, sheet rock, wiring, paint, hazardous and industrial waste and furniture of any kind.

VIOLATIONS of these conditions may subject to a \$750.00 fire call charge and or criminal actions.
