**WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE CLEANUP**

Residents who live in the City limits of Waterville. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses or those residing outside the City limits will be accepted.

**Residents must maintain a minimum distance of 10-feet from the collection vehicles while compactors are in operation.**

**ACCEPTABLE ITEMS AND PREPARATION GUIDELINES**

General Non-Hazardous Household Waste “junk”

Furniture items (Couches, Chairs, Tables, etc.)

**Small** amounts of re-modeling materials (Siding, Drywall, Carpet, etc.) in containers

All loose materials must be contained in bags, trash containers or boxes that can be safely loaded by one person

**Bagged material is limited to 25-lbs per bag; bags must be tied so they can be lifted from the top**

**Sharp objects such as broken glass must be enclosed in puncture proof containers**

**Absolutely NO loads of loose shingles or construction debris will be accepted!**

- Asbestos
- Batteries (Includes: auto, flashlight, rechargeable, etc.)
- Chemical Products (Includes: herbicides, pesticides)
- Medical Waste and Sharps (Needles)
- Fluorescent Tubes and Light Bulbs
- Hazardous, Industrial, Infectious Waste
- Any Liquid Waste including Paints, Thinners, Removers
- Oils, Oil Rags (Includes: any type of oil drilling waste)
- Radioactive Materials Naturally Occurring (NORM)
- Tires
- Yard Waste (Includes: grass clippings, tree and shrub waste)
