- Applied to FEMA
- Must have sustained flood damage to your home. (accessory Structures are not elidable).
- Have a loss not covered completely by insurance
- Have a need that is not covered by insurance, cash, or FEMA

Applications

Complete the short application form. Complete the appropriate sections and attach the required materials such as FEMA and SBA Disaster Loan information, insurance claims, etc. We have attempted to streamline this process as much as possible to make it easier on applicants by asking for the documents you have already filled out for other agencies. This allows the committee to keep the application process simple yet will provide transparency and will give the grant committee the information they need to determine who needs the assistance the very most.

*Applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Approval is at the discretion of the committee.
