

FHM Grant Program - Background

- Established in 1987
- Funded by the Legislature with G.O. bonds
- Provides cost-share funding to local governments
 - ➤ 1:1 non-state match
- Must be of a capital nature and publicly owned in perpetuity
 - > acquisition/removal of flood prone structures
 - > Easement acquisition
 - Structural works levees, floodwalls, diversions, impoundments, pumping stations

Acquisitions

Acquisition and removal of flood prone structures is a high program priority



Over 3,600 structures physically removed from the floodplain in Minnesota

Need to Know Info for Property Owners

- Is your structure "Substantially Damaged?"
 - Must be rebuilt in compliance with floodplain regulations
- Selling price determined based on pre-damage assessed or appraised value
- Likely Funding:
 - 75% FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program
 - 12.5% State FHM Grant Program
- No eligible activities until after funds are appropriated (e.g. demolition)
- Timelines:
 - Property owners with interest must notify city prior to 11/15
 - Spring 2025 City submits FEMA and State grant applications
 - If funded, transfer of ownership wouldn't occur until at least Summer of 2025
