There was an Emergency Meeting that the Waterville City Council held in the Council Chambers at 8:00 p.m. on June 25, 2024.

Call To Order / Roll Call / Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of Agenda/Additional Items to Agenda

Motion by Smith Seconded by McIntyre to approve the agenda as written Motion Carried 4-0.

New Business

Fire Department Emergency Response Request. Chief Meskan requested that the Council request 48-hour coverage by the Initial Attack Task For structure protection and Medical to provide the firefighters some down time. The response team request would consist of one type 1 structure engine with personnel and medical response capability with EMRS and EMT's, one type 1 tender with personnel, 1 Chief with command vehicle, one transport vehicle with trailer for Type 1 Engine and type 1 tender to transport across 4' of water or less (national Guard Asset). The estimated cost for the coverage is \$50,000 and would be eligible for reimbursement at 100 percent if a Federal Declaration is issued and 75% reimbursement with a State disaster declaration. This request would need to be approved by the City Council then a request would need to be made by the County. Councilmember Grobe requested clarification if they would be on call or in the fire station. Administrator Hill advised that they would be on site at the hall. Mayor Conlin questions if the cost would be more if they were held over due to an emergency call? Administrator Hill advised that if they were in the middle of an emergency call it is assumed that the hourly rate would apply. **Motion by Smith Seconded by McIntyre to approve the request for 48 hours of relief service for the fire department and request as outlined and to request that the request that. Motion carried 4-0.**
