## REMINDER REGARDING GRASS CLIPPINGS

Please do not mow or blow grass clippings into the street. This is prohibited by the City of Waterville Ordinance codes and may be subject to fines.

### 2025 CURB SIDE BRUSH PICK UP

Curb side brush pick up will be offered on the following dates:

- Tuesday, May 20
- Tuesday, June 17
- Tuesday, July 15
- Tuesday, August 19
- Tuesday, September 16
- Tuesday, October 21



Contact City Hall the Friday prior to any scheduled pick up date for services. Please note that brush will not be accepted if branches exceed a 2-inch diameter or a tree service has been hired for removal or trimming of trees. Please put cut ends towards the street

### Burning Permits

The City of Waterville requires residents to fill out an application for open burning. The application needs to be approved before burning can begin. You can pick up an application at City Hall during business hours or you can download and print the form from the city website. Recreational camp fires are not required to have a permit but they cannot be bigger than 3 ft. wide and flames no more than 3 ft. tall.
