

City of Waterville 2025 Spring Clean Up

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE IN THE CLEANUP

Residents who live in the City limits of Waterville. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses or those residing outside the City limits will be accepted.

Residents must maintain a minimum distance of 10-feet from the collection vehicles while compactors are in operation.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS AND PREPARATION GUIDELINES

General Non-Hazardous Household Waste "Junk"

Furniture items (Couches, Chairs, Tables, etc.)

Small amounts of re-modeling materials (Siding, Drywall, Carpet, etc.) in containers

All loose materials must be contained in bags, trash containers or boxes that can be safely loaded by one person

Bagged material is limited to 25-lbs. per bag; bags must be tied so they can be lifted from the top

Sharp objects such as broken glass must be enclosed in puncture proof containers

Absolutely NO loads of loose shingles or construction debris will be accepted!

- Asbestos
- Batteries (includes: auto, flashlight, rechargeable, etc.)
- Chemical Products (includes: herbicides, pesticides)
- Medical Waste and Sharps (Needles)
- Fluorescent Tubes and Light Bulbs
- Hazardous, Industrial, Infectious Waste
- Any Liquid Waste including Paints, Thinners, Removers
- Oils, Oil Rags (includes: any type of oil drilling waste)
- Radioactive Materials Naturally Occurring (NORM)
- Tires
- Yard Waste (includes: grass clippings, tree and shrub waste)
